

MOTOR CARS, MOTOR CYCLES

Personal effects may include any kind of non-commercial pleasure vehicle, such as cars, motorbikes, camper trucks, motor homes, trailers, snow mobiles, pick-up trucks, etc. Transport Canada Safety and emission standards must apply to all motor vehicles and trailers of any kind (non-motorised) less than 15 years old. Before attempting to import a motor vehicle in this category, be certain it has been manufactured to meet Canadian standards and bears a "compliance label". Motor vehicles may be subject to provincial sales tax. Ensure car is cleaned before shipping to avoid additional costs for inspections and/or steam cleaning.

You will be required to provide a passport, proof of ownership and previous registration and insurance documents. If you ship your car, you must attend Customs in person. Any single item of personal and household effects including a motor vehicle that was acquired after March 31, 1977 and is valued at more than \$10,000.00 on the date of importation is subject to regular duties and taxes on the excess amount.

PETS

You must provide a Vaccination Certificate and a Veterinary Certificate confirming the pet is free of disease. It is advisable to check with Animal Health Division, Agriculture Canada, Ottawa, Ontario K1A 0Y9.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Narcotics and drugs. Goods made from endangered species such as furs, ivory or reptile skins, plants.

FIREARMS

Do not ship firearms - check with Canadian Authorities first for further information Import Permits Bureau, External Affairs and International Trade Canada, Export Controls Division (KPE), Box 481, Station 'A', Ottawa.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Upon arrival into Canada as immigrant/returning Canadian or with a temporary VISA each person must report to Canada Immigration when there are goods to follow, and obtain the B4E declaration form.
